- Enter the new owner's details (must include name, address and a phone number)
- 6 Save
- 7 Record microchip number below and provide to new owner to complete (refer overleaf)

South Australian law requires breeders and sellers to provide the new owner with the dog or cat's information and update **dogsandcatsonline.com.au**



How to complete a microchip record as a new owner

Login* and select **Complete Microchip/Desexing Record** (and complete steps 3, 5 and 6 below), or

- 1 Select **Register***
- 2 I would like to **Register my new animal**
- 3 Enter Microchip number and your Surname
- Check if you have an account—
 if so, select it or continue as a **new owner**
- 5 Ensure your details are correct
- 6 Complete registration

All dogs and cats born after 1 July 2018 must be microchipped by 3 months of age or before sale and desexed by six months of age, unless exempt.

South Australian law requires all dog and cat microchip details to be kept up to date on dogsandcatsonline.com.au.
