A person who desexes or microchips a dog or cat must provide the mandatory information, within five (5) days of carrying out the procedure by:

(a) Entering it into the Dogs and Cats Online database; or

- (b) Creating a new animal profile in Dogs and Cats Online, if the dog or cat is not recorded in the Dogs and Cats Online database, and entering the mandatory microchipping information into the dog's or cat's record; or
- (c) Sending it to the Registrar for the council area within which the veterinary practice or microchip implanter operates; or
- Giving it to the owner of the dog or cat that is subject to the microchipping procedure.
