Accessible Trail details

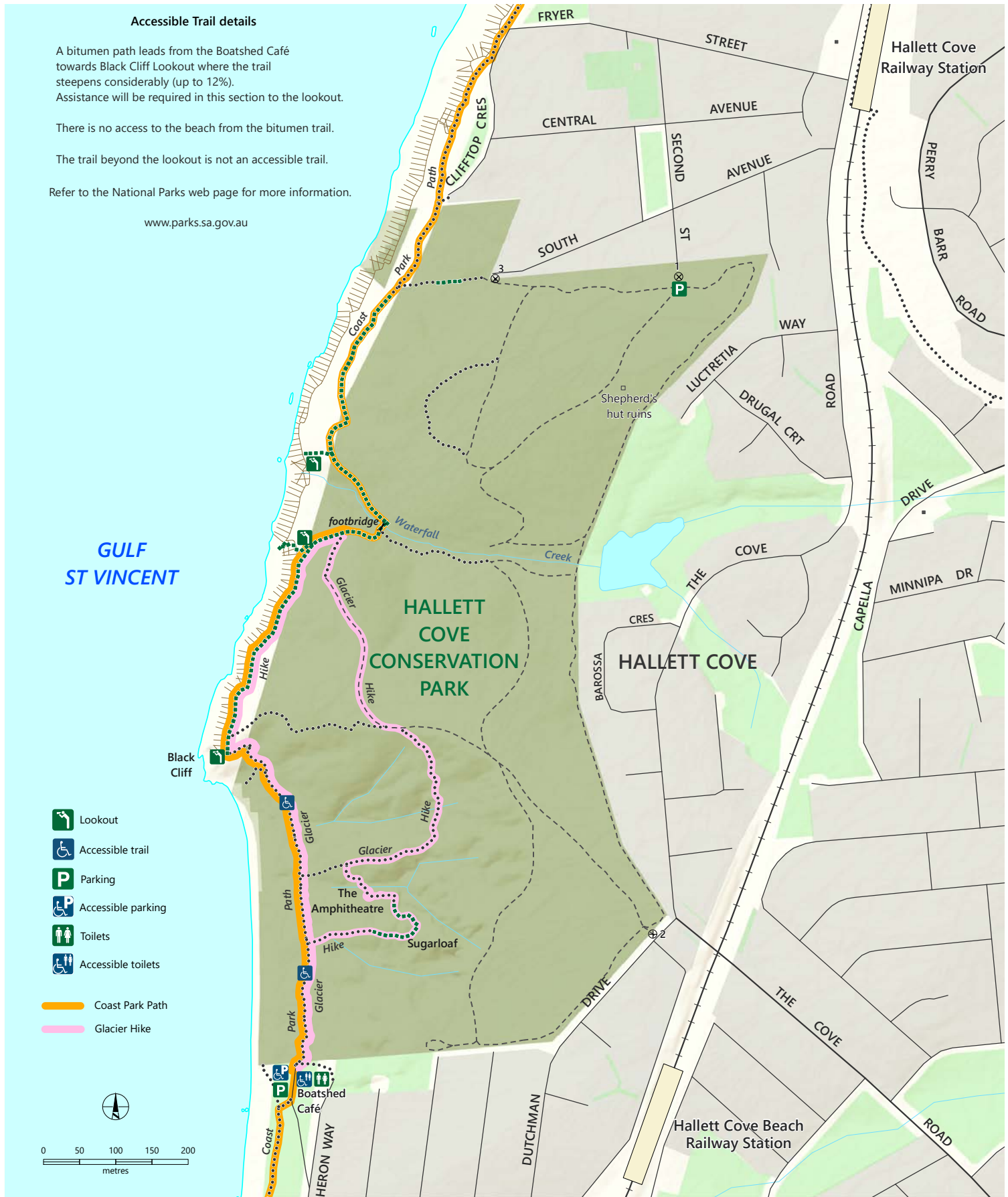
A bitumen path leads from the Boatshed Café towards Black Cliff Lookout where the trail steepens considerably (up to 12%). Assistance will be required in this section to the lookout.

There is no access to the beach from the bitumen trail.

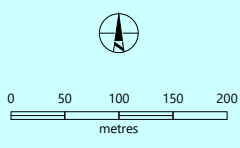
The trail beyond the lookout is not an accessible trail.
