Map 02 - Sanctuary Zones 2, 3, 4

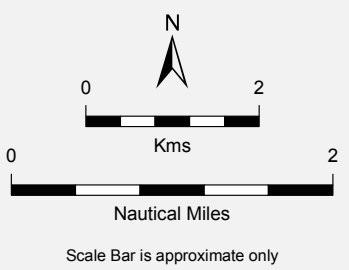

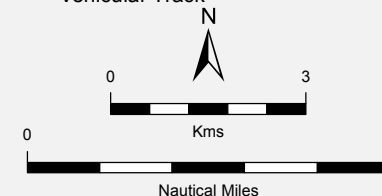
Map 03 Sanctuary Zones 5, 6, 7 Habitat Protection Zone 2 Special Purpose Area 8
